JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Research Fellow will be responsible for managing various activities that Duisenberg will perform as part of its partnership with Holland Financial Centre. Accordingly, he or she will initiate innovative research projects in the field of Finance & Sustainability and publish the results in leading journals.

There is also the opportunity for the job description to be expanded and for the Research Fellow to also design top-notch student and executive education curricula in the field of Finance & Sustainability and to teach on the Programme. This widening of the brief will depend on the candidate and their prior experience, and should this not be within their experience, should not be a reason not to apply for the post.

The Research Fellow will have the opportunity to work closely with Professor Noreena Hertz, who holds the Duisenberg Chair of Globalisation, Sustainability and Finance.

JOB QUALIFICATIONS:

We are seeking a candidate with a strong academic track record in the field of finance, who has either already done research in the finance and sustainability area, or can strongly support their desire to work in this emerging area. The candidate should also be enthusiastic about playing a part in guiding the development of Finance &

Sustainability at Duisenberg. It is expected that candidates will have finished their doctorates and perhaps already have had an initial postdoctoral research fellowship or lectureship. However, candidates who have recently finished PhDs will also be considered if their resume is particularly relevant and strong.

APPOINTMENT/SALARY

The appointment will initially be for a period of 3 years and may be extended beyond this period depending on the future development of the Programme. The salary will match the candidate's responsibilities and agreed job description and will be in the range of Euro 5000 gross per month, depending on expertise and previous experience. Other employment conditions will be favourable.
