The Department currently has a team of seven financial economists conducting research across a spectrum of financial topics. We are especially interested in adding an experienced economist whose research is focused on financial institutions, financial markets, or risk management.

JOB DESCRIPTION:

The primary responsibility of this position is to conduct original research for publication in academic journals. In addition, financial economists are expected to contribute to policy analysis related to their areas of expertise or broader interests. Examples of policy contributions include: (1) briefing the Bank's president on financial sector policy issues and/or the financial aspects of monetary policy; (2) assisting the Bank's supervision function by providing technical or analytical expertise; or (3) participating on Federal Reserve System workgroups pertaining to prudential supervision and/or financial stability issues.

Salary is competitive and rank will be contingent upon experience. The Federal Reserve is an equal opportunity employer.

JOB QUALIFICATIONS:

Candidates must have a Ph.D. in economics or finance, at least three years of experience, and an established research agenda. Excellent oral and written communication skills are also essential.
