Call for Papers

The 4th International Accounting & Finance Doctoral Symposium, which is focused on developing the research strengths and skills of doctoral students, is sponsored by the University of Leeds, Monash University, University of Plymouth, University of Queensland, Universidad de Salamanca and University of Strathclyde. This year's symposium builds on the tremendous successes of the previous meetings, which took place at the Monash University Prato Centre, Prato, Italy. This year the Symposium is taking place at Universidad de Salamanca, Salamanca, Spain.

This Symposium offers an excellent opportunity to students to present their work to an international audience outside their usual University environment. Prominent professors and researchers in the fields of accounting and finance will attend the Symposium and provide detailed feedback to individual participants on their research.

Scope

We seek original theoretical and empirical papers in the fields of accounting and finance, with an emphasis on results that contribute to solving the outstanding research problems that are of significant impact to these fields.

Submissions

The submission should be either an extended abstract, complete paper or work in progress. Each submission will be reviewed by the Doctoral Symposium program committee. The main evaluation criteria are:

- Quality of the research;
- The potential for impact; and
- Relevance to the accounting and finance disciplines.

Only electronic submissions in PDF or Word format will be considered.

Participation Fee

For accepted students to the program, the fee is €200. This fee covers registration, symposium documents, a welcome pack, lunch, coffee/tea and the gala dinner and cocktail.

An information pack including information on hotel and university accommodation, and their cost, and Salamanca and its university will be provided with the notification of the acceptance.
