Job Description

The successful candidate will be expected to develop, manage and execute both basic and advanced level courses within Finance, including courses for our Executive Education in Sweden and internationally.

The position also includes supervising students of all levels and contributing to the further development of the School's research and teaching within Finance. This includes independent research as well as developing a strong research connection within the education. Contributing to the School's internal development is also an important requirement.

Qualification requirements

A suitable candidate is in possession of a PhD in Business Administration oriented towards Corporate Finance or Financial Economics, or alternatively, a Swedish or international degree equivalent to a PhD in the mentioned disciplines. It is also a requirement to be experienced and highly skilled in teaching Corporate Finance or Financial Economics. In order to obtain a permanent position the candidate shall have completed at least 7.5 ECTS of teacher training for higher education or have acquired similar knowledge through different means.

The applicant must possess the ability to cooperate well with others as well as additional abilities and personal skills required to successfully fulfil the responsibilities included in the position.

Basis for assessment

Special and equal emphasis will be given to scientific and pedagogical expertise demonstrated through documented research and independent teaching. Recent publications in international journals (last five years) will be considered a great merit when evaluating scientific expertise and research activity.

A proven ability to cooperate well within both research and teaching, nationally and internationally, will be of utmost importance. It is also of great significance to be able to establish good forms of collaboration with the surrounding community and communicate research and other developments in a clear and effective manner.

Additional information

An applicant who wishes to be employed as a professor must clearly indicate this in the application and give evidence of advanced and research level teaching.
