

## **Finance Faculty Positions University of Chile, Santiago, Chile**

The Department of Industrial Engineering (DII) of the University of Chile is seeking applications to fill two fulltime positions in the area of finance at the Assistant or Associate Professor level. Ideally, the appointment will begin around May 2011. The salary is competitive.

### **Job Description**

The successful applicants are expected to have a strong academic record, including, a. Ph.D. in a relevant discipline from a top institution; a commitment to carry out independent research in any topic related to finance; and a willingness to teach graduate and undergraduate courses.

The new faculty will become affiliated with the recently established Financial Studies Center. This center, which will be hosted by the DII, is being funded, in part, by BCI, a Chilean-based international bank. The DII offers an attractive intellectual environment ideal for multi-disciplinary research. The department has forty full-time faculty members, most of them with doctoral degrees from leading U.S. or European universities; it is recognized as one of the best in Latin America; and it has a strong track-record in areas closely related to finance, such as applied economics, operations research, quantitative marketing, and applied math. Therefore, applicants working at the intersection of finance and another technical field should find these positions attractive.
