

The 7th RMUTP International Conference on Science, Technology and Innovation for Sustainable Development: Challenges towards the green innovative society

The 7th RMUTP International Conference on Science, Technology and Innovation for Sustainable Development hosted by Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon (RMUTP) will be held during **23-24 June 2016**. The conference focuses mainly on the event “Sustainable Development” proposed by the United Nation. The developed program has a purpose to meet the needs of all present generation and the future generation who do not require to compromise and/ or diminish their abilities to meet their own needs. As part of this conference, the Centre for Financial Econometrics (Deakin University) and RMUTP will jointly organize a session on the theme of “Innovation/technology, financial markets, and economic growth”. Selected papers meeting the standards of publication in Economic Modelling will be considered for publication in the journal by Professor Paresh Narayan (Editor, Economic Modelling) following the journal’s standard submission and review policy.

The proposed session welcomes papers on topics which are however not limited to the following : (a) technology and stock market performance; (b) technology and economic growth; (c) technology spillover between stock market to economic growth; (d) trading strategies and portfolio management that make use of technology; (e) technology and macroeconomic performance; (f) profitability of technology-investing/innovative firms; (g) technology and credit risk modelling; (h) technology forecasting; (i) technology and the predictability of financial markets; (j) technology and the predictability of economic growth; (k) technology and capital structures; (l) technology and corporate financial decisions (are family businesses more technology-investing?); (m) threshold effects of technology on economic growth; (n) speed at which technology facilitates economic growth and development and/or financial market development; and (o) technology, innovation, and competition.

Draft papers or extended abstracts of 500 words should be submitted to cfe@deakin.edu.au by **1 April 2016**. All submissions will be reviewed and a final decision will be conveyed to corresponding authors by **15 April 2016**.
