PAPER SUBMISSION PROCEDURE: Teams can submit their proposals through the competition website, http://www.hfcomp.net, by 11:59 PM EST on March 9th, 2017. Teams are asked to submit a pdf file at most five pages long describing the proposed investment strategy. Submissions must be "blind," meaning that the submission file must not indicate or hint at the submitting team's school affiliation or team member names. Identifying information will be entered into a form on the submission page.

FACULTY COORDINATOR: Each participating school is asked to select a faculty coordinator. Schools are asked to notify the competition organizers of who will serve as faculty coordinator by February 7th, 2017. Notification can be done by emailing Vikas Agarwal (vagarwal@gsu.edu) or Scott Murray (smurray19@gsu.edu). Because the competition will accept only two submissions from each university, should more than two teams from a given university want to enter the competition, the faculty coordinator will determine the two teams that will submit to the competition.
