

Job Description:

The Department of Business Economics at the University of Balearic Islands in Spain invites applications for faculty positions at the level of tenure track Assistant or Associate Professor in the field of Business Economics, Marketing or Finance. Open positions are to begin in September 2018.

The position involves both research and teaching. Candidates applying for the Business Economics and Marketing position with a background in Economics (industrial organization, organizational economics, personnel economics, behavioral economics, etc.), Management (human resources, strategic management, entrepreneurship, operations research, etc.) or Marketing (behavioral, quantitative, strategic, etc.) are welcome. Candidates applying for the Finance position should have a background in any major area of Finance (corporate finance, asset pricing, market microstructure, banking, quantitative finance, actuarial, accounting, etc.).

Candidates are expected to have completed their PhD by end June, 2018. Our department is growing and seeking for talented applicants who demonstrate a strong potential for research excellence and high quality teaching. Since most teaching in the University is either in Spanish or in Catalan, the ability to teach at least in one of these two languages is required in two years.
