Application Requirements

Each year, we welcome a select group of students to the ODU, Strome College of Business in the Ph.D. Program of Finance. The following are the general requirements that every candidate should meet in order to apply to the Finance Doctoral Program:

All applicants to the Finance Ph.D. Program are required to submit a complete application for admission. A complete application includes the online application, GRE or GMAT scores, statement of purpose, optional 1-2 pages essay, educational history and resume or CV, two (2) letters of recommendation, and academic transcripts.
