Call for papers

In spite of the uncertainty surrounding the Covid-19 virus, the organizing committee of the Paris December Finance Meeting plans to hold in-person its 19th edition in downtown Paris (Novotel Paris Les Halles) on **December 16, 2021**. The conference is organized by **EUROFIDAI** (European Financial Data Institute) and **ESSEC Business School**. Confirmation of the in-person conference will be communicated at the end of August 2021 depending on the evolution of the sanitary conditions. The conference will be held online again this year if the international situation was to remain critical.

The conference is jointly sponsored by Amundi / Ardian / BEDOFIH / CDC Institute for Economic Research / CERESSEC / Chaire Fintech (Paris Dauphine) / «Regulation and Systemic Risk» ACPR Chair.

All researchers are invited to present in English their latest research in all areas of finance and insurance. Job market and PhD papers are welcomed.

In recent years, one in six submitted papers was accepted. The Paris December Finance Meeting is one of the top 2 European conferences in terms of selectivity and the quality of the papers presented.

Prizes will be awarded for the best conference paper and for the best paper using EUROFIDAI data.

SUBMISSION PROCESS

Only on-line submissions will be considered for the 2021 Paris December Finance Meeting. Before filling the application form, authors should read the following instructions:

Prepare 2 files in pdf format:

- An anonymous version of the paper (the complete paper without the name(s) of the author(s), the acknowledgements and any indication of author's affiliation)
- A complete version of the paper including the following information: title, name(s) of the author(s), abstract, keywords, email address for each author, complete address(es)
- The abstract you will fill in the submission form should not exceed 150 words.
- To complete your submission you will have to classify your paper using 3 keywords among the following : Asset Pricing, Banking Regulation and Systemic Risk, Banking/Financial Intermediation, Bankruptcy, Behavioral Finance, Capital Structure, Corporate Finance, Corporate Governance, Derivatives, Entrepreneurial Finance, Ethical Finance, Financial Analyst, Financial Crisis, Financial Econometrics, Financial Mathematics, Financial Risks, FinTech and Cryptocurrencies, Hedge Funds/Mutual Funds, Historical Finance, Insurance, Interest Rates, International Finance, Investment Policy/Capital Budgeting, Market Microstructure/Liquidity, Merger and Acquisition, Ownership, Payout Policy, Portfolio Management, Private Equity/Venture Capital, Product Market Relationships, Real Estate, Risk Management, Security

Issuance/IPO. The keywords will determine the field in which your paper will be refereed by the scientific committee.

The submission fees for each paper is 45€.
