ABOUT THE POSITION

Toulouse Business School (TBS) in Toulouse, France is inviting applications for a finance professor position starting in September 2019. The rank and specialization are open. Applications for a visiting position will also be considered. Knowledge of French is not required (although learning it is encouraged), and both European and non-European citizens are welcomed.

ABOUT THE FINANCE AND ECONOMICS DEPARTMENT

Toulouse Business School has an ambitious, growing and friendly finance and economics department. Faculty members represent over half a dozen nationalities and hold PhDs from such institutions as California Institute of Technology, Cambridge University, Cass Business School, London Business School, and Toulouse School of Economics. We have published in Journal of Finance, Journal of Financial Economics, Review of Financial Studies, Journal of Financial Quantitative Analysis, Management Science, Review of Finance, Journal of Financial Intermediation, Journal of Banking and Finance, Rand Journal of Economics, Journal of Economic Theory, Journal of Economics and Management Strategy, Econometric Theory and Journal of Econometrics, among others. We are looking for candidates with similar ambitions. In the case of associate and full professor ranks, a history of publications in such journals is expected.

The department organizes workshops with leading international researchers (for a recent example, see <http://www.tbs-education.fr/en/actualites/corporate-governance-workshop>). We are located only a short walk from the Toulouse School of Economics, making it easy to attend TSE seminars and to collaborate with TSE researchers. ABOUT TOULOUSE BUSINESS SCHOOL

Toulouse Business School was one of the first French business schools to obtain AACSB, EQUIS and AMBA accreditations. The School has three campuses: Toulouse, Barcelona (Spain), and Casablanca (Morocco). It has a core Master "Grande Ecole" Program, lasting three years with roughly 450 students entering each year, which delivers a Master in Management; this program is offered on all campuses. There are three MSc in Finance programs (Corporate Finance, Banking and Financial Markets and Banking and International Finance), two MBA programs (Executive MBA and Aerospace MBA), and a Bachelor program. The School has formed a partnership with the Toulouse School of Management (TSM) to offer a joint PhD program (Ecole Doctorale) in Management.
